[PROPOSED] PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ORDER

For the reasons contained in this Court's Memorandum and Order (ECF No. 57), it is hereby ORDERED that a PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION is entered in this case. Defendants, their officers, agents, employees, and attorneys, and any other persons who are in active concert or participation with Defendants or their officers, agents, employees, or attorneys, 1 shall:

- 1. Be restrained and prohibited from implementing, giving effect to, or keeping in force any policies, memoranda, directives, or actions issued prior to the date of this order that were designed or intended, in whole or in part, to implement, give effect to, comply with, or carry out the directives contained in Executive Order No. 14,238, "Continuing the Reduction of the Federal Bureaucracy" (Mar. 14, 2025) (the "Reduction EO"), with respect to the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS), the Minority Business Development Agency (MBDA), or the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service (FMCS);
- 2. Promptly take all necessary steps to reverse any policies, memoranda, directives, or actions issued prior to the date of this order that were designed or intended, in whole or in part, to implement, give effect to, comply with, or carry out the directives contained in the Reduction EO with respect to IMLS, MBDA, or FMCS;
- 3. Be restrained and prohibited from taking any further action during the pendency of this case to "eliminate[]" "the non-statutory components and functions" of IMLS, MBDA, or FMCS, or to "reduce the performance of their statutory functions and associated personnel to the minimum presence and function

required by law," unless, as to each action, (a) Defendants provide a reasoned explanation for such action, including by taking into account any applicable reliance interests, and (b) such action will not prevent Defendants from fulfilling any of their statutory duties or expending funds appropriated by Congress; and

4. Within 7 days of the date of this order, file with the Court a status report that confirms Defendants' full compliance with this order and that details the actions Defendants have taken to comply with the order.
